F2 THE GLORY OF ANCIENT ROME AND COLOSSEUM

Skip the line - Half day walking tour

The tour starts from your hotel and continues with the visit to the famous Colosseum, whose correct name actually is Flavian Amphitheater, due to the imperial family who built this oval shaped structure in only eight years, from 72 to 80 AD. This huge monument, whose nickname comes from Colossus, a 35 meters statue representing the emperor Nero, was able to seat up to 70,000 spectators. It has been immortalized over the centuries as the scene of wild and ferocious games between man and beasts gladiators vs animals & gladiators vs gladiators as well represented in the movie Gladiator. Close to the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, considered the real political - commercial - social -religious center of Rome at the time of the Monarchy and the Republican period. At the center of the Forum, even after 20 centuries, it is possible to walk on the same cobble-stones of the "Via Sacra" (Sacred Way) leading to the Capitol Hill and admiring the ruins of its ancient basilicas, triumphal arches, honorary columns, ancient markets. Reaching Venice Square you will have the chance to admire the massive monumental complex, inaugurated in 1911, dedicated to our first King of Italy, Victor Emmanuel II.

At the end of the tour, keep some space in your heart for science and astronomy, as you will walk in the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, housing the one and only planetary sundial built by XVII century astronomers for the Pope to calculate the perfect sequence of day and night throughout the seasons.

F3 VATICAN MUSEUMS & ST. PETER'S

Half day tour to the Vatican Museums, one of the world's largest museum complexes, approximately 2,000 rooms that stretch for nearly 9 miles (15 km) inside the Vatican City. Skip the line with your small group of no more than 12 people. Stroll through the corridors to view the world's largest private art collection, once intended exclusively for the Pope. Through the Raphael's Rooms, four interconnecting chambers adorned with paintings realized by Raphael and his pupils, you will reach the beautiful breathtaking Sistine Chapel, the holy chapel where the Pope is elected and where the conclave is organized, a very special occasion to walk through this sacred Vatican site to admire Michelangelo's astounding frescoes. Then the visit continues inside the marvelous St Peter's Basilica, the largest church with a capacity up to 60,000 people, 25.000 square meters, 800 columns, 400 statues, 136 mosaics, 11 domes, 44 altars, full of masterpieces, wonderful architectures and sculptures, including the famous "Pietà", realized by Michelangelo when he was only a teenager.

F6 THE HEART OF THE ANCIENT ROME AND GHETTO

Half day tour walking tour

Enjoy a morning tour among two of the most iconic districts of Rome: Trastevere, whose name means on the other side of the river "Tevere", and the old Jewish ghetto. The tour starts from "Piazza Trilussa" in Trastevere and continues with the visit of St. Mary Basilica, one of the few remaining Byzantine churches in the city. Passing through the narrow alleys of the area, you will arrive to the Tiberine island, "Isola Tiberina", with its two important and well known hospitals and basilicas. Crossing the river you will see a huge complex called "Portico d'Ottavia", located in the old Jewish ghetto. During the Imperial age, the old market was housed in the Jewish district.

Walking through the small streets of the ghetto, you will discover the beauty of the Turtle Fountain, built by Gianlorenzo Bernini, maximum exponent of the baroque period, and the "S.Andrea della Valle" church in the real heart of the district. The tour ends at Giordano Bruno's square, the renown "Campo dei Fiori", where today one of the most important and crowded modern open-air market is located.

Half day tour exclusive walk downtown Rome

In this tour you will walk three times underground, through ruins and columns, you will enter a 2000 years old market and cross an island by the oldest bridge of Rome: it will be great fun for the whole family and children!

Is it true that every church in Rome is built over the ruins of pagan temples? That's what you will discover when you'll get in Saint Nicholas in Carcere, set over some very old places of worship! A short hop away, by Portico d'Ottavia and Marcellus theatre ruins, you'll cross the oldest bridge of Rome, 2000 years old and still standing!

There you are on the Tiber Island; next comes the underground house of Santa Cecilia, featuring ancient mosaics, mysterious inscriptions and a lavishly ornated crypt; at the end, you will visit the quite unknown church of San Crisogono built over a huge underground house, where archaologists found a large frescoed wall.

Let this adventurous, easy walk make your day as your guide will show you these ancient venues, unknown to the general public although set in the very heart of Rome!

Important notice:

This tour is intended as a walk which enters underground areas and places of worship: Should anyone feel uncomfortable in underground spaces, the guide can deal with it; those people will comfortably sit in the top church, while the rest of the group will visit the underground. It is advisable to wear confortable shoes such as sport trainers and to respect the churches dress code: trousers should touch the knee and shoulders should be covered; tourists may consider bringing a scarf to wear at necessity.

F7 CHRISTIAN ROME & UNDERGROUND BASILICAS

Skip the line - Half day Tour

Half day walking tour of Christian Rome to discover the underground treasures in some of the most sensational churches. The tour starts in the Lateran area, whose name comes from the family owner of the territory where the first Popes use to live before going to Avignone in France and come back to Rome later on in the Vatican area. Visit of *St. John Lateran Basilica*, the oldest of the four Papal Basilicas, considered "The Church of Rome", the mother of all churches The Cathedral, the place where the Bishop has the seat. Then the tour continues with the visit of *St. Clement's Basilica*, the only church in Rome to be built on 3 different levels, from the 1st to the 12th century and the underground floors can be explored, including the altar of Mithras from the 1st century. Continue to the *Church of the Four Crowned Saints*, dedicated to four anonymous saints and martyrs and where in the 2002, an extraordinary series of frescoes was discovered with scenes of the Zodiac, Four Seasons, Liberal Arts and King Solomon. The visit ends with *St. Peter's in Chains Basilica*, called like that for the chains that, according to the tradition, Helene – Constantine's mother brought in Rome and for a miracle where joined to the other St. Peter's chain in Rome. The church, furthermore, is very well renowned for the statue of Moses that Michelangelo created for the tomb of the Pope Julius II.
